

All My Papers announces its X9 Viewer with support for all four variations of the Universal Companion Document (UCD) in a Beta Release(3.0.1) available for download to selected financial organizations and current customers.

AMP is excited about this latest version of its popular X9 Viewer Windows .NET TM software application for Image Cash Letter (ICL) files. The X9 Viewer allows users to view, analyze, edit and auto re-balance the textual data and view the check image data(black and white and grayscale) in X9.37/X9.100-180 standards with support for many bank variations of ICL files.

Since the implementation of the Check Clearing Act for the 21st Century (Check 21), the banking industry has been rapidly transforming from a paper-based check clearing structure to an image-based system Ongoing interoperability issues have impacted the industry's ability to realize the full value of check image clearing. One obstacle to true interoperability has been the use of the check Image Cash Letter file format standard. The creation of the UCD establishes a consistent approach for all industry participants to use when processing check image files.

This version of the X9 Viewer supports the Universal Companion Document for industry best practices developed by the CheckImage Collaborative, initiated by the Electronic Check Clearing House Organization (ECCHO) and the Retail Payments Office (RPO) of the Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta, is comprised of representatives of trade and financial organizations from across the country.

The UCD clarifies the DSTU X9.37 standard. The primary changes are to:

simplify field validation by creating three sub classes:

- Validation Required
- Validation Required if data present
- No Validation required.

clarify Returns by delineating Monetary and Administrative Returns. require explicit conformance to X9.100-181, the "Tough Tiff" standard .

In addition to the baseline version for exchange, the new version of the X9 Viewer software supports the unique requirements of the following exchange networks:
